Montarbor Homeowners Association would like to present its owners and residents an opportunity to contribute to the communities efforts in recycling. Should you wish to participate, the following are two options both are provided bi-monthly (on the 1st and 3rd week of the month) and picked up on the same day as regular trash pickup (which is Friday). The difference in these options are what items may be recycled and the costs.



Option 1: Aluminum, newspaper and #2 plastics separated into white or clear bags provided by the owner and placed for pickup with the regular trash.
Cost: \$0.00

Option 2: All recycle items (per list) can be placed into one tote provided by the service provider. The cost will be added to the owner's monthly assessment.
Cost: \$3.00 per month

PAPER			
Including newspaper, inserts, advertising flyers, magazines, envelopes (with or without windows), and junk mail.	Place all paper items in recycling cart.		Dirty or contaminated newspapers. Hard Cover Books. Dirty or contaminated papers or paper towels.
CARDBOARD			
Including all types of cardboard, fiber board, cereal boxes, etc.	Flatten Boxes. Cut large pieces small enough to fit loosely into cart.		Dirty or contaminated cardboard. (Pizza Boxes)
FOOD & BEVERAGE CONTAINERS			
 Plastics 1 - 7	Wash containers		Food & Beverage containers NOT made of glass, tin, aluminum, or plastic
 Glass Bottles	Labels and neck rings DON'T have to be removed.		Containers larger than 1 gallon
Plastic Bottles	DON'T break the bottles.		Other cans or glass bottles (paint cans, medicine bottles, etc.)
Tin Cans, Aluminum Cans, Aluminum Foil	Place excess in paper bags next to the recycle cart. DON'T use plastic bags.		Other glass items (light bulbs, window glass, dishes, etc.)
Wax Cartons (milk & orange juice)	NOTE: Plastic bottles can be clear or colored and include detergent bottles, bleach bottles, shampoo bottles, etc.		Ceramic items (bottles, dishes, flower pots, etc.)
